

# Holter CPT Codes

## Quick Guide

Extended Wear Holter (EWH) with monitoring lengths of 3-7 days and 8+ days are fully covered by Medicare, Federal and Private insurance plans.

Below are the codes you will need to use when billing for Cardiac Monitoring Service Extended Wear Holters.

### Key Information

- 3-7 days and 8+ days billing for Medicare
- A 1-2 day monitoring period could be failing to pick up an arrhythmia around 50% \* of the time.
- CMS can provide you with data reports about detection rates, day of significant findings and even demographics.

## Traditional Holter Should Be Largely Unaffected

Changes to Extended Wear Holter (EWH) reimbursement structures will not change traditional 24hr Holter test reimbursements.

## Non-Physician Providers Will Be Able To Supervise Diagnostic Testing

CNM, CNS, NP, and PA are able to prescribe and bill for EWH services.

## Rules Are Subject To Change

## Billing Options Under The Medicare CPT Codes

- **Split Billing** – You charge for hook up and report interpretation (Professional Components) of the test, and we charge for the scanning and analysis report (Technical Components)
